Announcements

Rule in Focus – Parking

- As detailed in Section IX of our [Rules and Regs document](#), anybody parking on the street must parallel park and only in a designated area
- Any vehicle parked improperly is subject to being towed at the owner’s expense
- Parallel parking only in designated areas is designed to ensure emergency vehicles (e.g., firetrucks, ambulances) can navigate our roads

Event in Focus – Eid al Adha

- [Eid al Adha](#) is the Islamic Festival of the Sacrifice
- As with all Islamic holidays, the specific day it is celebrated is subject to the moon sighting
- This holiday originates from Abraham bringing his son to be sacrificed, only for him to be replaced with a goat
- This story is largely consistent with the story told in Christianity and Judaism, however in Islamic tradition, Abraham’s son Ishmael is brought to be sacrificed, not Isaac
